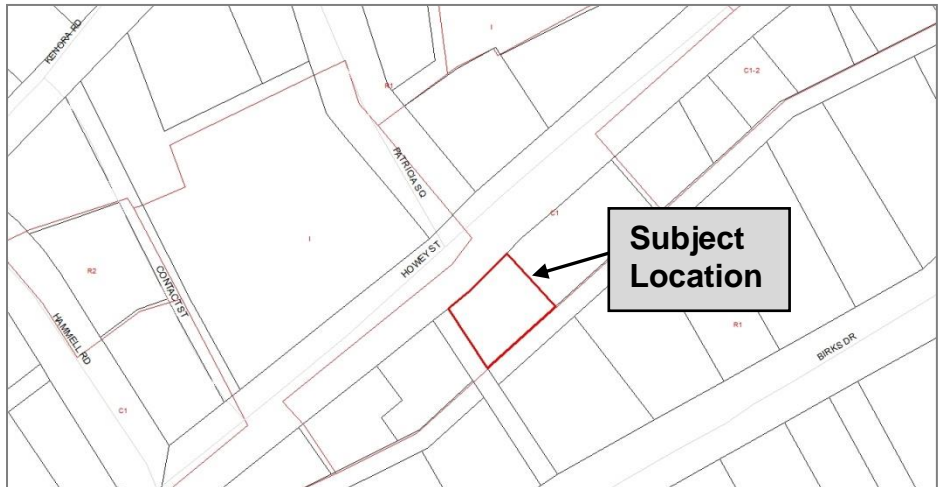
NOTICE is hereby given, that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake passed By-Law No. 45-2017 at their Regular Meeting held Monday, July 17th, 2017, thereby giving approval to a Zoning By-Law Amendment.

LOCATION OF PROPERTY: 220 Howey Street. Refer to the location sketch.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF BY-LAW: To change the zoning to Institutional with a Site Specific Provision to allow for an emergency shelter and apartment unit for transitional housing, in an existing building.

THE LAST DATE FOR FILING A NOTICE OF APPEAL is Wednesday, August 10th, 2017.

OTHER PLANNING APPLICATIONS RELEVANT TO THE SUBJECT LOCATION: None.



Notices of appeal:

- i. must be filed with Christine Goulet, Clerk of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake
- ii. must set out the reasons for the appeal, and
- iii. must be accompanied by the fee required by the Municipal Board of \$300.00

Only individuals, corporations and public bodies may appeal a by-law to the Ontario Municipal Board. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or the group on its behalf.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of appeal unless, before the by-law is passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the council or, in the opinion of the Ontario Municipal Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
