



**NOTICE OF DECISION FOR
OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT (D09-20-01) – BY-LAW NO. 20-2020
ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT (D14-20-01) – BY-LAW NO. 21-2020**

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake passed By-Law No. 20-2020 and By-Law No. 21-2020 at their Regular Meeting held Monday, March 16th, 2020, thereby giving approval to an Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-Law Amendment.

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION: There is no description or map as the amendments are not site specific.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF BY-LAW: The amendments to the Zoning By-Law entail: revisions and additions to the definitions and general provisions related to Public Use; and changes to the Official Plan to add general policies regarding Public Use.

THE LAST DATE FOR FILING A NOTICE OF APPEAL is Thursday, April 9th, 2020.

OTHER PLANNING APPLICATIONS RELEVANT TO THE SUBJECT LOCATION: None.

Notices of appeal:

- i. must be filed with Christine Goulet, Clerk of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake;
- ii. must set out the reasons for the appeal; and
- iii. must be accompanied by the fee required by the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal of \$300.00

Only individuals, corporations and public bodies may appeal a by-law to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or the group on its behalf.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of appeal unless, before the by-law is passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the council or, in the opinion of the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
